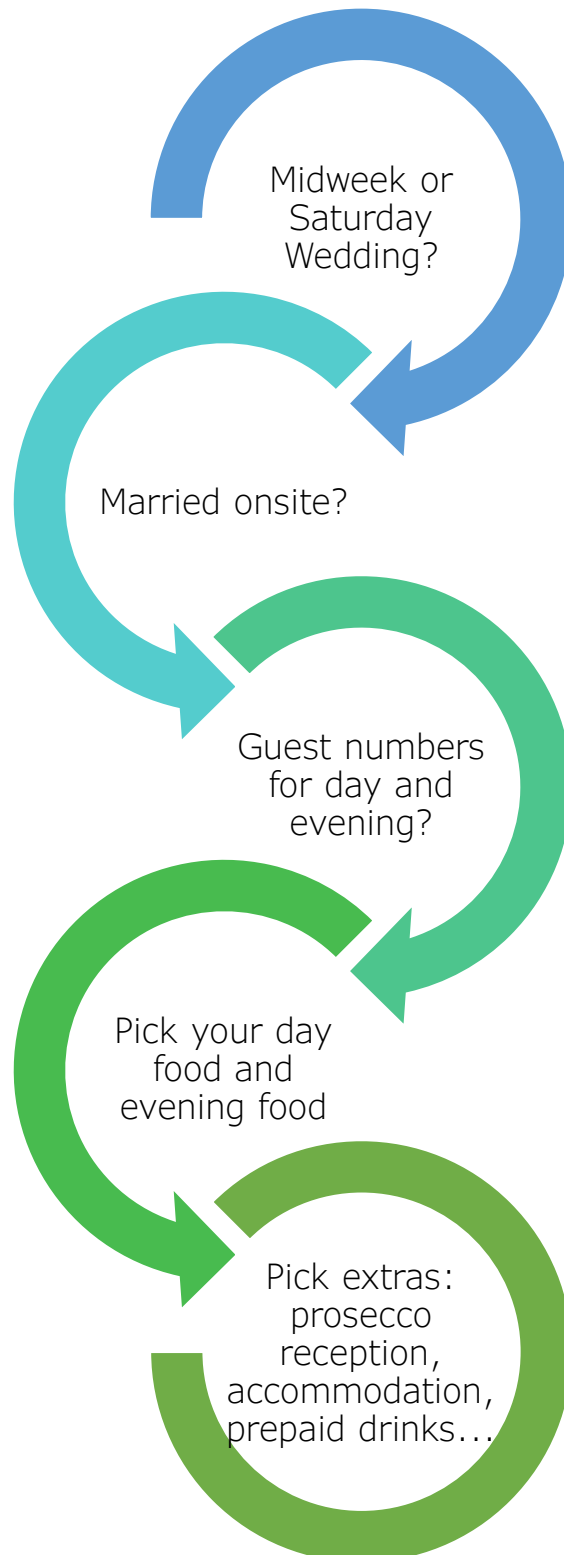

# CIVIL MARRIAGES & CIVIL PARTNERSHIPS



We, the venue, charge £350.00 to get married onsite.

You also need to book the registrar directly for a specific time and date. Fees for registrars attendance are as follows, based on 1<sup>st</sup> April to 31<sup>st</sup> March:

Mon-Thurs	Fri-Sun	Bank Holidays
£420	£460	£545

A couple must allow a minimum of 28 days from when they give their notice of intention to marry or civil partnership before they can get married.

Nottinghamshire registrar service contact number is 0115 977 5742 to book a registrar.

Note: On your day, the registrar will need to see each of the bride and groom separately prior to the ceremony. Usually, if you have booked one of the cottages, the groom will see the registrar in the ceremony room and then the registrar will go to one of the cottages to speak with the bride. Otherwise, the bride can see the registrar in the Gatehouse (tearooms)

# FINE PRINT

## Guest numbers

Include the bride & Groom. Also include how many are under 10 years old and how many are under 3 years old

## Food

Quality ingredients and freshly made food on site. Prices are based on numbers and requirements. Dietary requirements (vegan/vegetarian/gluten free etc) well catered for. Children under 10 years old half price. Under 3 years old free.

## Venue

There is ample parking and restrooms. Tables and chairs are included, there are 16 rustic wooden trestle tables (6foot long, 2foot, 2inches wide seating three either side snugly or two either side spaciously) and 85 wooden cross back chairs. Decoration/flowers to be organised by the wedding party. Use of basic PA & speakers.

## Entertainment

Feel free to organise your own singer, band, musicians, DJ. Feel free to organise your own wedding games or entertainment such as bouncy castle, inflatable slide, coconut shy, teacups, Buckin' Bronco or inflatable gladiator.

## Decorations

Feel free to organise for a decorator, florist or decorator yourself to add some personalisation to your day. No nails Sellotape or blue tac etc which may mark or damage.

## Sparklers

Allowed

## Catering photographer & DJ/Band

It is generally expected that you will cover the costs to feed the photographer(s) and DJ/artist/band

## Confetti

We only allow real petal confetti to be used onsite

## Outside catering

Not allowed

## Fire pit

Not allowed

## Booking

50% deposit of the venue fee is required to confirm your booking and reserve your date i.e. £1,500 for midweek weddings. Final guest numbers, itinerary, dietary requirements and payment of the balance to be three months prior to your date. The venue fee is fixed at the time of booking and is not subject to change. All other prices are indicative and could increase reasonably in line with inflation and other price increases. All prices are inclusive of VAT.

## Refundable Deposit

£300 deposit is to be paid with the final payment which is fully refundable. No alcohol is to be brought on site. This deposit includes damage (beyond wear and tear) and if alcohol is brought on site. We do not wish to take any of the deposit and wish for you to have a stress-free day so if you could please tell guests not to bring alcohol on site, as to not disrupt your day.

## STEP BY STEP

### Step 1: Is Beauvale Priory for you?

Visit Beauvale Priory anytime the tearooms are open (Fri-Sun 9.30am-4pm) or organise a wedding tour by emailing through the website.

### Step 3: Secure a date

Find a midweek or Saturday date that works for you. We can hold a date for you for two weeks whilst you check with key friends, family and suppliers. To secure your date a deposit of 50% of the venue cost is required. i.e. £1,500 for a midweek.

### Step 4: Ceremony onsite?

If you would like to get legally married onsite, you need to contact and pay Nottinghamshire Registrars directly on 0115 977 5742. A couple must allow a minimum of 28 days from when they give their notice of intention to marry or civil partnership before they can get married. Be ready, they will ask you to book a time slot.

### Step 5: Plan your itinerary (Rough)

Estimate guest numbers, decide your food choices, set your timings, think about extras such as prosecco reception, canapes, pre-paid drinks, desserts.

### Step 6. Suppliers

Book in your key suppliers: -

- Photographer
- PA or singer/Band or DJ
- Florist or decorator
- Makeup artist

### Step 7: Finalise your itinerary

Receive your RSVP's to finalise numbers & send in your final plans

### Step 8: Pay the balance

The balance is due at least three months prior to your date

### Step 9: Enjoy the build up

## THE OLD GUESTHOUSE

The Old Guesthouse, dates back to 1343 and was originally used as the Monk's guest house, when on the rare occasion they would have visitors to stay. With one of the oldest and last remaining pieces of Carthusian woodwork left in the country. Used for Civil marriages and civil partnerships for up to 45 people, the guest's entrance, welcome drinks, quiet space, extra seating and food area.



## THE SHOOT ROOM BAR & GinTin

Sit snugly by the log burner in the Shoot Room Bar with seating capacity of 25 plus standing. The GinTin is housed in the courtyard.



## THE PRIORY RUINS AND GROUNDS

Feel free to roam around the grounds and say hello to the sheep, chickens and if you're lucky the resident peacock- Percy.



## THE FOOD

Quality ingredients and freshly made food on site.



## ACCOMMODATION

There are two traditional cottages situated within the grounds of the historic Priory. Each two-bed cottage has been newly built to the design of the 17<sup>th</sup> century farmhouse.





## THE COURTYARD MARQUEE

Situated in the courtyard, the marquee connects the old guesthouse to The Shoot Room Bar, the courtyard and beyond in to the beauviale rolling fields and Priory Ruins.

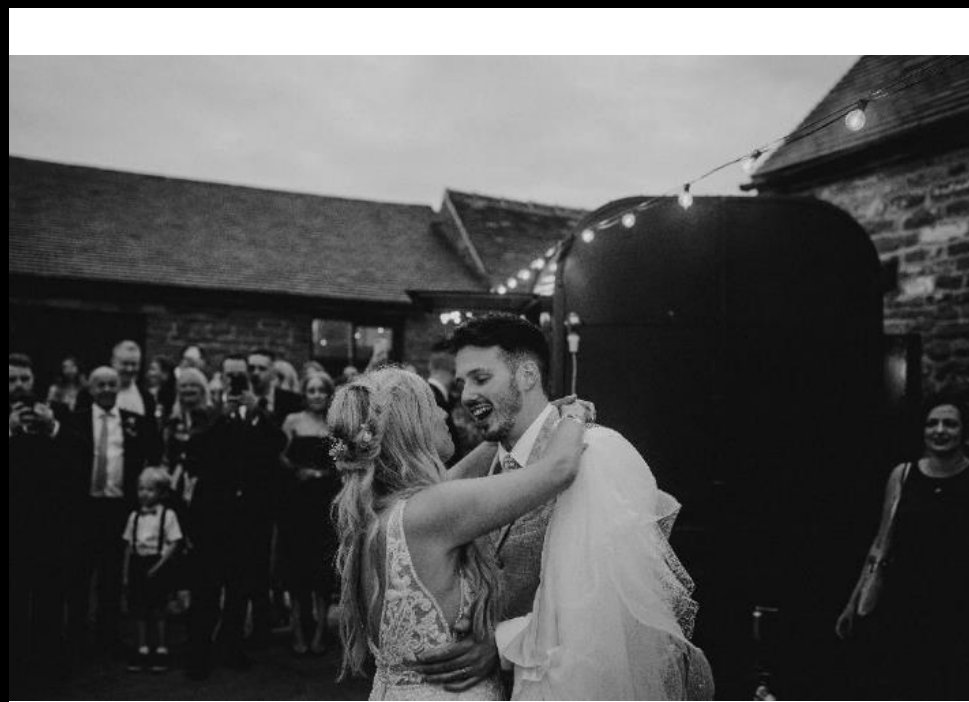
